The City of Schenectady Police Department will be holding a Police Officer Exam in November.

The results of the examination will be used to establish an eligible list to fill vacancies for the City of Schenectady Police Department as needed.

**TO APPLY:** Applications will be accepted from

## September 2<sup>nd</sup>, to September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2014

**EXAMINATION SUBJECTS:** The test is divided into four sections. The specific skills tested are applying written information in police situations, memory for facts and information, reading, understanding and interpreting written information and preparing written materials in a police setting.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATION:** Must be a high school graduate or possess a GED equivalency and have completed 30 College credit hours (transcript must be included when applying).

**DRIVER'S LICENSE:** Candidates must possess a valid New York State Operator's license at time of appointment and maintain such license throughout the tenure of employment.

**RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS:** Must 19 years old but no more than 35 years of age (or 41 years of age with military service) to take the exam but you will not be eligible for hiring until you become 20 years old. Must be a resident for at least 1 month before the exam. Must be willing to work nights, weekends and holidays.

**DUTIES:** Enforcing laws and ordinances, protecting lives and property in an assigned area, routine patrol tasks, assisting in investigation of criminal offences, and apprehending criminals.

**TO BECOME A POLICE OFFICER:** You must submit to a complete background check, medical and other screenings, a qualifying physical fitness test, muscular endurance, and cardiovascular capacity which consist of 1.5 mile run.
