1. Participants must submit 3 different braided hairstyles on 3 separate models each with 3 photographs displaying the front, back and side views of each style. Each model you choose must be willing to sponsor you by donating \$ 10.00 each, this will help potential future stylists begin to create an established clientele. The photos must be presented on a poster or tri board presentation billboard, along with an autobiography of yourself and why you like to braid hair, who your models are, a brief statement about their hairstyle, and the length of time it took you to complete. You will be judged by your peers in the community for this portion of the competition, so be creative and invite friends and family to come. Presentations must be received by June 1, 2015.
2. All entries that are accepted will compete on June 20, 2015 during the Juneteenth Celebration in the Pavilion. Participants will be required to complete a natural braided hairstyle in two hours where you will be judged by professional licensed stylists who are salon owners. Styles will be judged on your creativeness, consistency, neatness, timing, and how well the style suits your client, along with your entry presentation and the amount of adult tickets each participants sells, which helps participants to learn to advertise and market themselves.
