The Schenectady County Environmental Health Department has an opportunity available for a full-time **Public Health Technician**.

SALARY: \$40,757/year

Employees who meet the following minimum qualifications may apply:

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- A. Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with an Bachelor's Degree including a minimum of fifteen (15) semester credit hours in the natural sciences*, of which not more than six (6) credit hours may be in applied sciences**; OR
- **B.** Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with an Associate's Degree including a minimum of fifteen (15) semester credit hours in the natural sciences*, of which not more than six (6) credit hours may be in applied sciences**; and two years' experience in environmental health; hydrogeology; biology; chemistry; physics; or epidemiology.

NOTE: Candidates must satisfactorily complete a public health training course approved by the New York State Health Department within two (2) years of appointment.

*Natural science shall mean a science such as biology, chemistry or physics that deals with the objects, phenomena or laws of nature and the physical world. It shall include all physical and biological sciences.

**Applied science shall mean science based courses in environmental technology, sanitation technology, medical technology, public health, infection control or food science.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:

Possession of a current valid New York State driver's license at the time of appointment and maintained throughout employment.

NOTE: The essential functions of this job are determined by the department/jurisdiction where the job is located.

APPLICATION: Civil Service applications will be accepted from employees who meet the minimum qualifications. CSEA bargaining unit members will be given preference in appointment, based on seniority.
